- 7. Project Description
 - (i) Background

: Bangladesh is a developing country of one of the least developed regions of the world. Like other countries of the world, efforts for development are there and ultimate objective of all these initiatives is to achieve the indicators of the Millennium Development Goals (MDG).

Bangladesh is on schedule to achieving MDG 1 by 2015. But its economic growth process has not sufficiently benefited the extreme poor. Over seven percent of the population is categorized by the **United Nations** Development Programme as "extremely poor". About a fourth of the population Bangladesh is considered "extremely impoverished", devoting nearly all of their daily income to food consumption. Economic and social inequalities prevail at large and a huge portion of the population is deprived of essential services and commodities.

MRDI has not directly implemented any poverty reduction project, but has demonstrated sustainable contribution to the development sector through media. Our regular media monitoring helps us design

projects and derive agendas to contribute to national development. Understanding of MRDI is that achievement of economic growth requires attention on different sectors such as: improving transparency, accountability and efficiency of the Government and in all key areas, including taxation, public procurement, land administration, justice, regulation of banking and credit market and ensure Right to Information in all sectors.

Income inequality in Bangladesh rose in nineties, particularly in urban areas. So the challenge is reaching the poor and promoting pro-poor growth. Creation of more jobs and opportunities for entrepreneurship and self employment by the poor will need to be speeded up. Alternative development fund should be considered instead of dependency on donor. Enhancing cooperation and partnership among Government, private sector and civil society will scale up MDG and PRSP.

In our country context some groups of the poor are chronically vulnerable, and face vulnerabilities that are regional or seasonal in nature. Targeted interventions will need to be designed and prioritized taking into sustainable safety net programme. Halving the proportion of people who suffer from hunger is being a challenging task for the government and donor.
